Agenda Item III. Review November 20th, 2013 Meeting Minutes.

Agenda Item IV. Old Business

At the November 2013 meeting there was a discussion about the 2014 goals. One suggestion was how the CDDO could provide assistance with tracking information such as; persons served satisfaction with provider choice and the services they are receiving with the implementation of KanCare. The membership will need to discuss this further at the next meeting. Several of the Council of Community Members are no longer able to serve on the council so one goal could be the recruitment of new members.

Agenda Item V. New Business

KanCare was implemented February 1st 2014. Weekly conference calls continue with Kansas Department of Aging and Disability Services (KDADS), Managed Care Organizations (MCO), Community Service Providers (CSP), Targeted Case Managers (TCM), and the Community Developmental Disabilities Organizations (CDDO). Many questions remain unanswered and this is still a work in progress. Crisis requests are still reviewed by the CDDO's then sent to KDADS for either approval or denial. MCO Care Coordinators are currently doing the Health Risk Assessments on individuals on the underserved list. The Shawnee County CDDO will be reviewing and updating policies to reflect all the KanCare changes.

Sunflower Supports no longer provides Targeted Case Management services as of December 31st 2013; they will continue to provide day and residential services.

Agenda Item VI. CDDO Report – Sabrina Winston

Sabrina reviewed the CDDO statistical report. There are 1079 adults and children receiving services in Shawnee County.

There are two new affiliated providers in Shawnee County. Avance-d Community Alternatives provide residential services and Integrated Behavioral Technologies, Inc. provide Targeted Case Management services, Positive Behavior Support, Personal Assistant Services, and Financial Management Services.

Barbara McCummins talked about her volunteer positions at Legacy, KNI and Atria; she loves getting out in the community and socializing. Barbara has a much more active lifestyle today than in the past where she was at home the majority of the time.
